At a regular meeting of the DeWitt Charter Township Board held at the Township Hall, 1401 W. Herbison Road, DeWitt, MI on the _____ day of _____, A.D., 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

The following Resolution was offered by Member _____ and supported by Member _____.

WHEREAS, the Township deems it advisable to create a special lighting district to be known as **DeWitt Crossings South**; and

WHEREAS, the Township deems it advisable to create a special assessment roll to defray the cost thereof pursuant to Act 264 of 1917 (as amended, C.L. 41.251 et seq); and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to hold a public hearing thereon.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Supervisor shall obtain from the utility company serving said area an estimate of the cost of construction and expense of lighting system necessary to serve said area.
2. That the Supervisor shall prepare a tentative special assessment roll assessing the cost of said improvements upon the lands benefitted thereby.
3. That the Clerk shall cause a Notice of Public Hearing regarding the question of the establishment of said district and the hearing of objections thereon and upon the roll to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the Township not less than five (5) days before the date of said public hearing, which date is hereby established as the **26th day of April, A.D., 2021, at 7:00 p.m.** at the DeWitt Charter Township Hall, 1401 W. Herbison Road, DeWitt, Michigan.
4. That the Clerk shall also provide notice of said hearing, by first class mail, to all owners of all parcels or parties in interest concerning said property in the area described as said persons shall appear on the last local tax roll, i.e. as established after the last Board of Review with subsequent amendments and

that said notice shall be mailed not less than ten (10) days before the date of said hearing.
