A DTPD officer observed a vehicle with an improper plate committing a traffic violation. A traffic stop was initiated as the vehicle pulled into a local motel. When the officer approached, the driver of the vehicle sped away. Officers tracked the suspect vehicle until it eventually crashed into a tree. The suspect then fled on foot ignoring commands to stop. The suspect was ultimately detained, and a large amount of narcotics was located on their person. The suspect continued to be uncooperative, even during medical treatment. The suspect is facing multiple felony charges.

DTPD was notified of a suspicious situation at a local drive thru restaurant. Employees reported that a customer was falling asleep while in line. Officers located the suspect still in their running vehicle and contact was made. The suspect appeared confused and was therefore given several roadside sobriety tests. The suspect admitted to using narcotics before driving. The suspect has been charged with OUID and possession of narcotics.

Catalytic converter thefts have continued to be a problem and DTPD has taken measures to identify suspicious activity quickly. Officers received notification of suspects at a local mini storage facility. Four suspects were identified on scene, two of which fled in a vehicle. The suspects still on scene were quickly taken into custody and admitted to removing a catalytic converter from a vehicle. The two suspects that fled the scene nearly struck an assisting officer and were pursued until their vehicle crashed. In addition to the cut-off converters and burglary tools located with the suspects, narcotics and open intoxicants were found. All four suspects are facing multiple felonies.

DTPD officers responded to multiple overdose incidents in October at various locations. Officers were able to utilize the NARCAN that is kept in all patrol cars to perform life saving measures.
