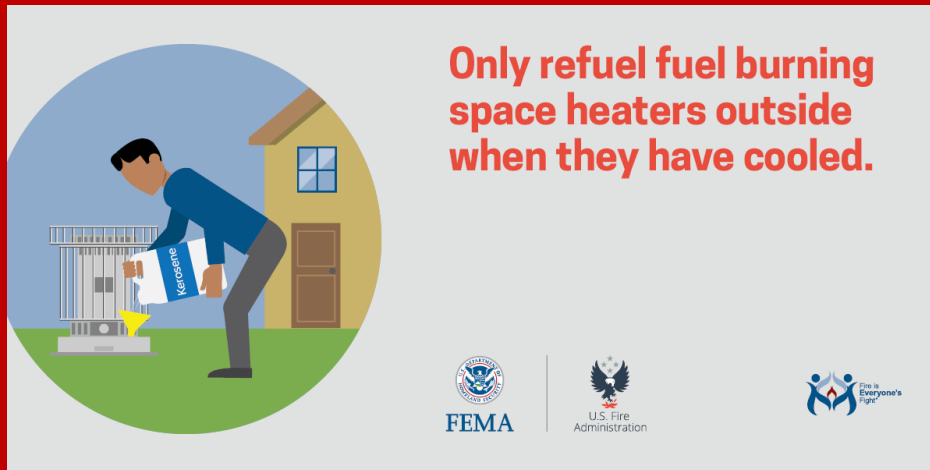

Narratives of Major Incidents

February 19th at 1608 hours, DeWitt Township Fire was dispatched to an unknown motor vehicle crash at US-127 and Coleman Road. DeWitt Township Fire responded with two apparatus and seven personnel. Clinton Area Ambulance Service was also dispatched to the scene. Two people refused medical care.

February 22nd at 1224 hours, DeWitt Township Fire was requested as Mutual Aid to assist Laingsburg Fire (LSW) on a very large barn fire in the 7000 block of W. Hibbard Road. DeWitt Township Fire responded with three apparatus and six personnel. DeWitt Township Fire assisted with water supply, extinguishment, and overhaul. DeWitt Township Fire cleared the scene at 1734 hours.

February 22nd at 1752 hours, DeWitt Township Fire was dispatched to a motor vehicle crash on I-69 near Business 127. One vehicle crashed into the ditch. DeWitt Township Fire responded with three apparatus and five personnel. Mercy Ambulance also responded to the scene. One person refused medical treatment; the second person was transported to the hospital.

February 22nd at 2001 hours, DeWitt Township Fire was dispatched as Auto Aid to Bath Township on a reported kitchen fire. The fire was in the 3800 block of Coleman Road. DeWitt Township Fire responded with three apparatus and eleven personnel. The fire was contained to the oven.
